To publish the outcome of the research team, the college has published a journal - Journal of LITES. It has already published two volumes and it is published once in six months. This year Third volume was released in the Christmas day function

#### Faculty Development Programme:-

A One Day Workshop for Faculty Members on "Quality of Teachers" was organized by college at Tholamai Illam, Kanya Kumari on 23.06.17. On 24.06.17 an orientation was given by Epracto Company, Chennai to the staff on 'Online Aptitude and Technical learning'.

#### MoU:

MoU was signed with Scott Christian College and Women's Christian College for sharing of library books.

For placement in top companies like Nissan, Wipro, Honey well MoU was signed with Banyan Company.

#### **SACL Activities:**

With an aim of making our students to get actively participate in the holistic act of charity; **Social Awareness Club of Loyola (SACL)** is formed. A group of members of SACL (Students of a class, Students of a Department, Staff, etc) will meet out the

### **Future Plans:**

- Another 20 students will be trained exclusively to develop a useful Innovative product. They will be starting their own startup companies.
- Based on their GRE/ GATE score one set of students will be moving for higher Education in Western countries.
- In 2 years, **LITES** will be accredited
- Within another 3 years **LITES** will be Autonomous.
- Many MOUs will be signed with Foreign Universities & Industries
- The student after his 7<sup>th</sup> semester should be doing his project where he is placed.
- **LITES** will be participating in many Research areas
- Naturally, this opens his eyes; and he sees the vast opportunities around him.
